Xavier High School in Cedar Rapids, Iowa is the state's sixth-largest Catholic high school and the only Catholic high school in the Cedar Rapids metropolitan area. 60% of faculty have a M.A. or Ph.D. in their area; 100 percent of Xavier students are involved in community and parish service; 100 percent of Xavier students are issued an iPad as an academic tool in its 1:1 Digital Learning Environment; 98 % of Xavier graduates pursue post-secondary education; 94% of Xavier students are involved in at least one co-curricular activity; 78 % of Xavier students are involved in three or more co-curricular activities; 88 extra-curricular programs to choose from; 90% of Xavier students complete four years of Science; 68 % of Xavier students complete four years of Mathematics; 40 % of Xavier students complete four years of foreign language; 40 courses at Xavier are honors and AP courses; 4 dual credit courses are offered through St. Louis University; 11 is the average number of years that faculty members have devoted to Catholic education; 32 IHSAA/IHSGAU team athletic state championships!

Xavier High School in Cedar Rapids, Iowa is the only Catholic high school in the Cedar Rapids metropolitan area. Cedar Rapids /'si:dər 'ræpɪdz/ is the second-largest city in Iowa and is the county seat of Linn County. The city lies on both banks of the Cedar River, 20 miles (32 km) north of Iowa City and 100 miles (160 km) northeast of Des Moines, the state's capital and largest city.

## Facilities

Its campus encompasses a full 60 acres (240,000 m<sup>2</sup>) in northeastern Cedar Rapids. The 146,500-square-foot (13,610 m<sup>2</sup>) facility is capable of managing up to 811 students under the current layout.

Xavier enjoys several advantages in facilities over other Metro area high schools. The football, baseball, softball, and soccer fields are all located on-campus, as well as two full football and soccer practice fields. Newly remodeled tennis courts are on-campus as well. A disk golf course is in place throughout the grounds for students' use at their leisure. There is a pond on the eastern edge of campus that students may use for recreation and fishing as well as professional water polo. Xavier provides an iPad for each student.
