Crespi Carmelite High School, established in Encino, CA, in 1959, is an all-male, Catholic, college preparatory high school conducted by the Carmelite Order. Current enrollment is 460 students with an average class size of 18, and a student-to-teacher ratio of 12:1. For the Class of 2024, 100% of the graduates matriculated to higher education, 85% to four-year colleges. Crespi offers a curriculum satisfying all requirements for college entrance plus a wide range of programs, including athletics, art, and drama. .

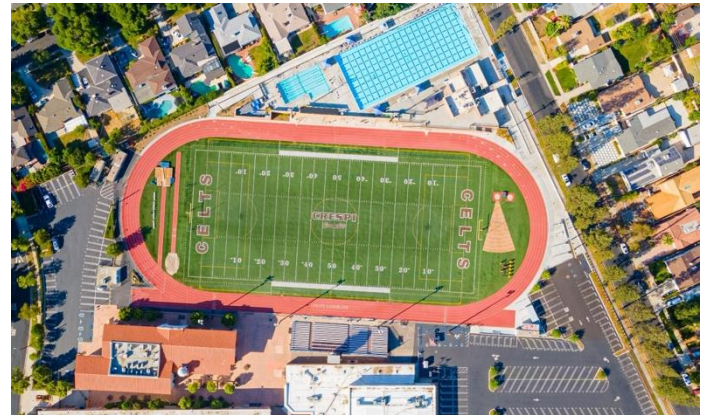
## College Matriculation

Crespi Carmelite High School offers a well-equipped suburban campus designed to support academic, athletic, and artistic excellence.
