

Student Basic Compliance and Parental Consent Form

Considering that the participants are minors, parents will jointly guarantee it, so make sure that the students are fully understood rules as below:

- 1. Students cannot carry alcohol, cigarettes, illegal drugs, and weapons at any time.
- 2. If students damage or steal school property or host family property or others, students are responsible for compensation for the loss.
- 3. Bullying or alienating others will be immediately expelled from the program.
- 4. Students must follow the instructions of the coordinators and staff and do not disturb the students who are studying.
- 5. Linguistic and physical violence is prohibited under any circumstance.
- 6. Students cannot leave school without the permission of the supervisor or the coordinator, and students must be on time for meals and outdoor activities.
- 7. Students do not make unnecessary physical contact with each other's even if students are of the same sex.
- 8. Students cannot use smartphones or other electronic devices during classes.
- 9. Students must try to use only English as much as possible when other people are around.
- 10. Any promotional materials containing photos of AnB students may be used for several years.

Failure to comply with the participant compliance regulations stated above may result in immediate expulsion and termination from the program. In addition, in the event of money loss, the parents are responsible for it.

■ Regarding Room Placement

1. The room placement reflects parents' opinions as much as possible, but "Parents" do not object to the assigned room.



- 2. The room is assigned to two students, but in some cases, it may be assigned to one room per student.
- 3. If there are students from the same country assigned together, students of the same gender will be assigned in principle, but in some cases, students of a different gender can be assigned, and in this case, prior consent from "parents" will be obtained.
- 4. "Participants" do not raise objections by comparing the room during the camp.
- 5. ""Participants" represent their home country. Therefore, always be considerate and act/speak appropriately.

■ Termination Policy

- 1. "Participants" agree that AnB Education has the right to expel students from the program and send them back to their home country immediately if the participants continue to act in violation of U.S. national law or harm the image of "AnB Education".
- 2. Fighting is absolutely prohibited. "Participants" agree that should they get into any altercation, they will be terminated from the program and sent to their home country immediately.
- 3. "Participants" can return to their home country in the middle due to homesickness or maladjustment if "participants" and "parents" want to.
- 4. If you are terminated from the program in the middle due to the above matters, the cost for the rest of the camp will not be refunded, and the "parent" must pay all the expenses incurred due to the return in advance.
