

The campus is 14 acres in size and the school is small but well-equipped. The school's 72,000-square-foot teaching building is equipped with classrooms, science and computer labs, music classrooms, art studios, libraries, churches, gymnasiums and restaurants. There are softball, football, rugby venues on the stadium, hard courts, an independent playground for the lower grades of elementary schools, an outdoor amphitheater, and a picnic area.



In addition to physical education classes, the school's activities include: basketball, flag football, football, softball, volleyball.

High school girls participate in three California Intercollegiate Federation (CIF) campaigns: volleyball, basketball and softball. Boys participate in the flag football game in the Adventist League, as well as CIF basketball, golf and volleyball.
