The school now sits on a beautiful seven-acre campus, located only 17 miles from Pennsylvania Station, and offers state-of-the-art indoor facilities, including a historic auditorium and a modern library/technology center. The indoor facilities, all of which are connected, feature a historical main building, dedicated in 1921, a large gymnasium, a modern library/technology center, an historic auditorium known as Hessel Hall which was originally built in 1929 and refurbished several years ago. With over 30 classrooms, Lawrence Woodmere Academy features interactive white board technology in most every teaching space in a wireless environment.

College Matriculation
