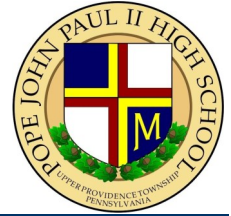

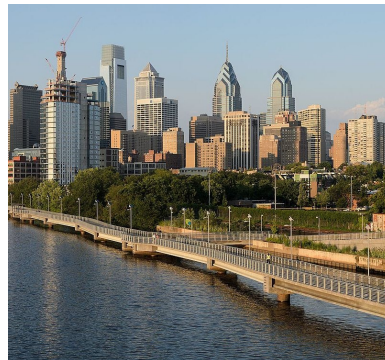

Royersford is a borough in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, 32 miles (51 km) northwest of Philadelphia, on the Schuylkill River, and a member of the Spring-Ford Area School District. The town drew its name from the location of a ford across the Schuylkill River, which happened to be adjacent to land owned by the Royer family. The population was 4,752 at the 2010 census.
