For nearly 100 years, St. Margaret's School has offered girls an outstanding college preparatory education. We offer grades 8–12 and a postgraduate year for day, boarding, and five-day boarding students. School offers opportunities for advanced study in Honors and Advanced Placement classes, independent study, and dual enrollment in college courses. Field trips throughout our region, environmental study and fieldwork, international travel and exchange, research, independent study, and internships are all opportunities that will be open to you at St. Margaret's. 75% of students play sports, 2018 LIS Softball Champions, six players chosen for the all-LIS team, and LIS Softball Coach of the Year; 11 teams, 42-acre athletic complex, LIS Volleyball Coach of the Year for the past four years. 26 Performing Arts and Visual Arts courses are available. 2018 graduates received over 110 college acceptances and more than \$475,000 in scholarships.

Our 10-acre waterfront, campus on the banks of the Rappahannock River with its 42-acre athletic complex in Tappahannock, Virginia, is centrally located in a small, safe town with lots of charm. St. Margaret's is within 1–2 hours of Washington, DC, Fredericksburg, Richmond, Charlottesville, Williamsburg, and Virginia Beach.
