

Dual Enroll in College: Williamsburg Christian Academy offers a comprehensive fine arts program that includes visual arts, music, and drama classes, along with an AP Art History course and an art gallery showcasing works that align with various subjects. The performing arts program features choral and instrumental music, helping students develop their musical skills and learn to read music. Through the Dual Diploma Program, students earn credits in math, science, world languages, and electives that contribute to their WCA transcript and high school diploma. The school also offers an International Baccalaureate program with courses in math analysis, biology, music, Spanish, visual arts, English, physics, French, and history.

Additionally, the residential program includes daily Bible courses, small-group Bible study, praise and worship, and prayer and scripture at the beginning and end of each day.

FACILITIES



The school features a 65,000 sq ft, two-story building with classrooms, labs, and a gymnasium, along with outdoor fields for soccer, field hockey, and baseball, and an indoor gym for basketball and volleyball. Students enjoy a nature trail for cross-country running, ample parking, and a dedicated art studio. The Science Sandbox provides hands-on science learning for lower school students, while the student art gallery showcases work and exhibits from the Virginia Museum of Fine Arts. The performing arts program includes chorus, theater, and puppetry, and the main dining hall serves nutritious, home-cooked meals. Additionally, the residential program offers daily Bible study and prayer, creating a supportive community for boarding students.
